

We will be paper piecing with Cheri from Busy Bee in Edgewood. This will be a combined project/block of the month. For those of you not interested in paper piecing just bring your UFO's to work on. While Cheri is instructing we would just ask for quiet so those who need to can hear her.

We will be making a flower block which has **4 separate 6" flowers** that are sewn together to **make one 12 1/2" block**. Cheri has included separate cutting directions just in case someone wants to make each flower a different color combination.

This is what you will need for each flower block. If all 4 blocks are to be the same you will multiply this by 4. If each block is to be different you will need 4 sets of cuts.

Piece #1 (flower center) 2 1/4" X 2 1/4 " sq.
Piece #2 (background) 2 1/4" X 2 1/4" sq.
Piece #3 (background) 2 1/4" X 3 3/4"
Piece #4 (part of flower) 2 3/4" X 3 3/4"
Piece #5 (part of flower) 3 3/4 X 6 3/4"
Pieces #6 & #7 (background) 4" X 6" for each piece.

You will need an add-a-quarter ruler, either the 6" or 12". Cheri may bring some with her tomorrow that you can purchase. I will have extras you can borrow.

You will also need a sewing machine needle smaller than 90/14, a glue stick or long straight pin, and your regular sewing supplies.
